- ldentify mechanical failures and resolve them yourself or arrange for fixes by a mechanic. This requires truck drivers to carry and know how to use machining tools like socket sets, wrenches, screwdrivers, hammers, and punches.
- Manage difficult weather conditions such as working during severe winters or droughts to deliver essential items to clients and individuals.
